

# Assembly Instructions for Treated Pine Kid's Picnic Table

**Items: FCFTSA**

## **Tools Needed for Assembly**

Hammer for light tapping  
Pliers or 7/16" socket set

**Step 1** Lay out and identify all parts and pieces.

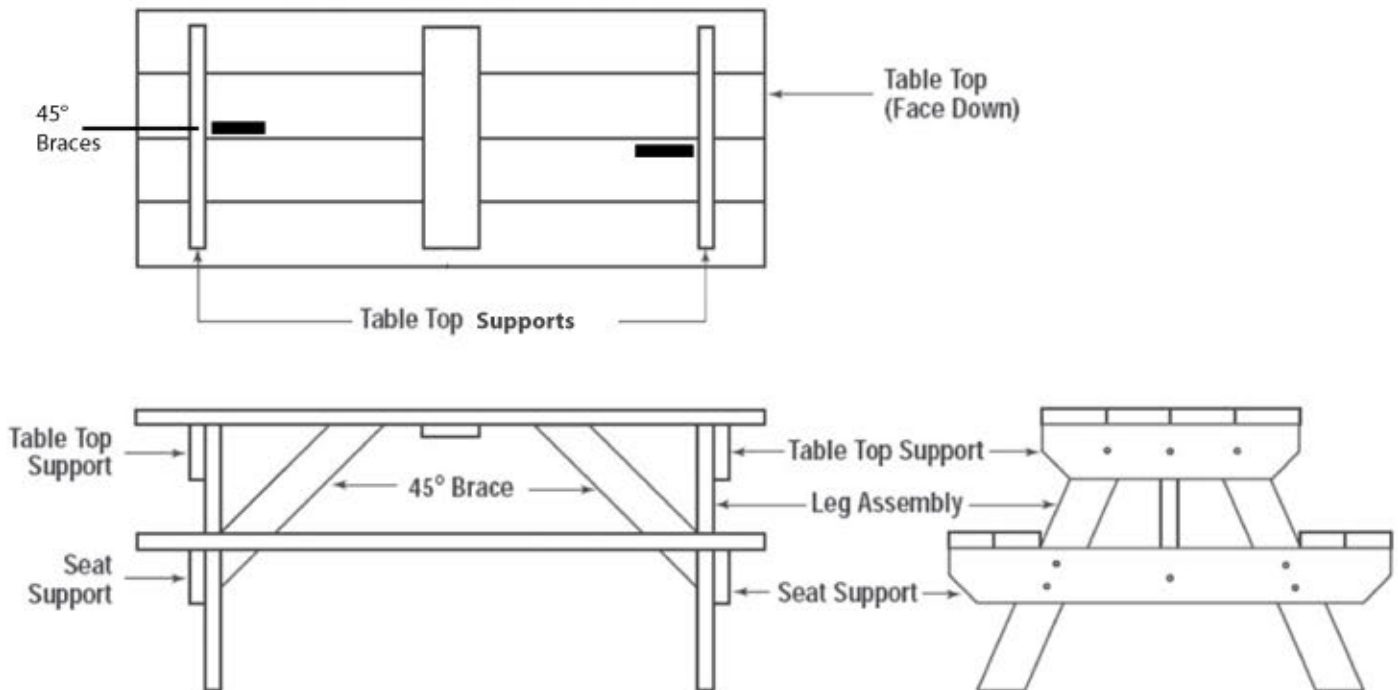
**Step 2** Lay the top upside down on a clean surface (we recommend using the box that the top was shipped in for the flat and clean surface). Attach the leg assemblies onto the table top braces with four 3-1/4" bolts then secure with a 1/4" flange nut.

Before putting on the leg assemblies, be sure the seat supports face the outside while putting it on the inside of the table top support.

**Step 3** Add the 45° Braces. Place either end of the 45° angle brace onto the table top (see diagram) and up against the table and bench support. Use 2" wood screws to secure the 45° Brace.

DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN! Repeat the same steps on the brace on the opposite..

**Step 4** Stand the table upright. Place benches on the table and bench supports with the bench top brace underneath being on the outside of the table and bench supports. Fasten in the same manner as the table top. Now, Tighten all nuts. Enjoy your picnic table.

## **Hardware**

1/4" x 3-1/4" Carriage Bolts and Flange Nuts (12)  
2" Wood Screws (8)

Checking (cracks in the wood) may occur with these products. This is normal and natural occurrence in wood, and will not affect the structural integrity of the wood and this product.
