
Assembly Instructions for 4', 5', 6', 8', & 10' Red Cedar Cross Legged Picnic Tables

- Step 1 Lay out and identify all parts.
- Step 2 Take the table top and lay it upside down on a flat clean surface (we recommend using the box that the top was shipped in for a flat and clean surface).

Take the table legs and attach them to the top of the table. Be sure the braces face the inside of the table top



- Step 3 Line up the predrilled holes and tap a hex bolt through them. If the holes aren't lining up, loosen the two nuts on the leg to allow for play. Once aligned, put on a washer and nut and tighten.
- Step 4 Next, take a lag bolt and twist it into the brace and into the underside of the table top and into the leg and then do the same with the other leg.
- Step 5 Set your table upright and lay the benches on top of the table upside down. Follow the same procedure as in Steps 1-4 with the smaller legs for assembling the benches.
- NOTE: Braces for the 4 foot table will have different angles in order to accommodate an umbrella pole.

NOTE: Due to product variations, the parts list may be different than what you actually receive with your product.
