Cedar Table w/ Attached Benches Assembly Instructions (4', 5', 6')

Please read through instructions entirely before beginning assembly.

Tools Needed for Assembly

7/16" Socket Hammer for tapping bolts #2 Square Bit (Included)

Parts List

- 1- Table Top Assembly
- 2- Seat Assemblies
- 2-Leg Assemblies
- **2-45° Braces**

Hardware List

8- 3" Bolts
4- 2 1/2" Lag Screws
8- 1/4" Nuts
16 - Large Washers
4- Small Washers



Step 1 Lay out and identify all parts and hardware.

Step 2 Lay the top upside down on a clean flat surface. We recommend using the box that the product was shipped in. Attach the leg assemblies onto the table top braces with four 3" bolts using a large washer under the head and nut of each bolt.

Before putting on the leg assemblies, be sure the table and seat supports face to the outside while putting it on the **inside** of the table top brace.

Step 3 While the table is upside down, attach the 45° braces. Place the 45° angle of the small brace onto the table top and up against the horizontal brace of the table and seat support. Note: You will have to offset each 45° brace slightly so the brace misses the gap between the middle boards. Take 2 1/2" lag

screws with a small washer and put it through each end of the 45° brace. using a hammer, lightly tap the lag screw into the table top. Note there are no pre-drilled holes for the 45° braces. We do not predrill for strength purposes. Then tighten with a 7/16" socket. Repeat on seat support. Do not over tighten! Repeat the same steps on the brace on the opposite end.

Step 4 Stand the table upright. Place seat assemblies on the table and bench supports. Fasten in the same manner as the table top. Tighten all nuts. Enjoy your picnic table!
